

BELLS BOARD MEETING
FEBRUARY 9, 2015

Aldermen present: Bob Pigue, Scotty Runions, John Pigue, Dabney Long and Eric Jordan. Mayor Joe Williams, presided. Alicia Pigue, Recorder.

Others present: Wesley Eubanks, Josh Work, Chief Jernigan, Angel West, Chief Jenkins, Junior Jordan and Martha Edmonds.

Mayor Williams called the meeting to order and gave invocation.

Alderman Eric Jordan moved to accept the minutes of the previous meeting with the following amendments:

- OMIT "Alderman Scotty Runions moved to reimburse Mayor Williams' health insurance premium every month at \$317.09. Alderman John Pigue seconded the motion. All Aldermen vote, Aye. Motion carried."
- OMIT "Alderman Scotty Runions moved to begin working on murals on the corners of the downtown areas. Alderman Eric Jordan seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried."

Thereupon Mayor Williams called for a roll call vote with all Aldermen being present and all Aldermen voting, "Aye". Motion carried.

Mayor Williams reported that the City's Sewer flow is down by around 50% according to our new meter.

Mayor Williams reported there are liens on the Butler property.

Mayor Williams reported that the sales tax allocations that belonged to the City of Bells will be returned in the next few months.

Mayor Williams reported that the changes in the Employee Handbook were not yet finished.

Mayor Williams discussed using the Senior Citizens Center as a Local Community Center.

Mayor Williams reported the Dixie Youth League has called to receive their \$5,000 yearly donation.
