

**BELLS BOARD MEETING
FEBRUARY 13, 2017**

Aldermen present: Bob Pigue, Scotty Runions, Dabney Long and Eric Jordan. Alderman John Pigue, absent. Mayor Joe M. Williams, presided. Alicia Pigue, Recorder.

Others present: Junior Jordan, Chief Jenkins, Katie Searcy Taylor, Mary Frances Williams, Alma Sherron, Martha Edmonds, Kevin Ligon, Jasper Taylor and Jere Kail.

Mayor Williams called the meeting to order and gave invocation.

Alderman Eric Jordan moved to accept the minutes of the previous meeting as written. Alderman Scotty Runions seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.

City Attorney Jasper Taylor explained the City Code concerning property maintenance regulations and further discussed proceedings taken place against Jose Luis Vargas for the property parcel 089F A 5.00 on Front Street in Bells.

Mayor Williams discussed January financial reports and sales tax.

Mayor Williams presented a City of Bells Title VI Compliance Manual for adoption. Alderman Eric Jordan moved to adopt the Manual as presented by Mayor Williams. Alderman Dabney Long seconded the motion. Thereupon Mayor Williams called for a roll call vote with all Aldermen voting, Aye. Motion carried.

Mayor Williams presented the meter flow chart for Pictsweet and the City of Bells into the Lagoon system. Pictsweet YTD 82.6%. City of Bells 17.4%.

Mayor Williams presented a proposal to pave the following roads estimated at \$167,301.

- Rogers Rd
- Robin Rd
- Davis Street dead end to Church Street
- Church Street (Davis to Logan)
- Logan Street (dead end of Logan to Davis St Ext)
- Davis Street Ext
- Mclemore Street
- Searcy Street
- Patterson Street
- Front Street (79 to Main)

Alderman Scotty Runions moved to pave the roads and further authorized Mayor Williams to begin the bidding process as presented. Alderman Dabney Long seconded the motion. Mayor Williams called for a roll call vote with the following results: Alderman Bob Pigue, Aye; Alderman Scotty Runions, Aye; Alderman Dabney Long, Aye; Alderman Eric Jordan, Aye. With the Aye's having the vote Mayor Williams declared the motion carried.

Ms. Katie Searcy Taylor addressed the board about stolen street signs (Searcy Street and Dr A. C. Jenrette Street), street conditions, ditch conditions and additional need for Police patrol at the Andrew Walker Park.

Being no further business Alderman Eric Jordan moved the meeting adjourn. Alderman Dabney Long seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.
