

**BELLS BOARD MEETING
APRIL 10, 2017**

Aldermen present: Scotty Runions, John Pigue, Dabney Long and Eric Jordan. Mayor Joe Williams, presided. Alicia Pigue, Recorder. Alderman Bob Pigue, absent.

Mayor Williams called the meeting to order and gave invocation.

Alderman Dabney Long moved to accept the minutes of the previous meeting as written. Alderman John Pigue seconded the motion. Aldermen Dabney Long and John Pigue voted, Aye. Aldermen Scotty Runions and Eric Jordan, Passed. Motion failed and Mayor Williams reported that the minutes will be put on the next meeting when those that were present at the March meeting could vote.

Mayor Williams reported the results from the bid opening from April 5, 2017 for the current street paving project. The results were as follows:

- Frank Climer and Sons: \$181,520
- Ford Construction: \$167,367.62
- Martin Paving: \$154,662.20

Mayor Williams requested awarding the project to the low bidder Martin Paving at \$154,662.20. Alderman Scotty Runions moved to accept the low bid as requested and further moved to authorize Mayor Williams to execute any and all necessary contracts needed. Alderman Eric Jordan seconded the motion. Thereupon Mayor Williams called for a roll call vote with all Aldermen present voting, Aye. Motion carried.

Mayor Williams reported the Pictsweet flow year to date is 81% Pictsweet: 19% City. He further reported on Sales tax and March Financials.

Mayor Williams reported that the recent Sewer Bid for the CDBG grant were being reviewed.

Ms. Cherry Raines discussed blighted properties.

Ms. Jackie Jackson discussed dogs running in her neighborhood.

Being no further business Alderman Dabney Long moved the meeting adjourn. Alderman Eric Jordan seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.
