

APRIL 13, 2015
BELLS BOARD MEETING

Aldermen present: Bob Pigue, Scotty Runions, John Pigue, Dabney Long and Eric Jordan. Mayor Joe Williams, presided. Alicia Pigue, Recorder.

Others present: Chief Jernigan, Chief Jenkins, Junior Jordan, Charlie Moore, Richard Davy, Gary Emison, Quinton White, Chloe Hopper, Maddie Coulston, Shelby Griffin, Ali McGee, Robert Rowe and Jordan Saylor.

Mayor Williams called the meeting to order and gave invocation.

Alderman Eric Jordan moved to accept the minutes of the previous meeting as written. Alderman Dabney Long seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.

Mayor Williams welcomed the Crockett County Youth Leadership members.

Mr. Richard Davy, Director at Bells City School, recommended appointing Mr. John Copeland to the empty school board seat. Alderman Eric Jordan moved to appoint Mr. Copeland to the School Board as recommended. Alderman Dabney Long seconded the motion. Thereupon Mayor Williams called for a roll call vote with all Aldermen being present and all Aldermen voting, Aye. Motion carried.

Mayor Williams presented the financial position.

Mayor Williams discussed repairing the Nutrition Site house. Alderman Bob Pigue moved for the Mayor to get a comparison of demolishing the house and adding restrooms versus remodeling the house and reporting back to the Aldermen at the next meeting. Alderman Eric Jordan seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.

Mayor Williams presented two resolutions **“STATE OF TENNESSEE DEFERRED COMPENSATION PLAN 11 -401(K)- RESOLUTION AND PARTICIPATING EMPLOYER AGREEMENT”** AND **“STATE OF TENNESSEE DEFERRED COMPENSATION PLAN 1 - 457(B) RESOLUTION AND PARTICIPATING EMPLOYER AGREEMENT.”** Alderman Bob Pigue moved to adopt the resolutions as presented and further authorized Mayor Williams and City Recorder Alicia Pigue to execute all necessary documents. Alderman Scotty Runions seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.

Mayor Williams reported that the Sales Tax owed to the City by Crockett County had been paid in full.
