

JUNE 10, 2019
BELLS BOARD MEETING

Aldermen present: Scotty Runions, Lee Overton, Dabney Long and Eric Jordan. Mayor Joe M. Williams, presided. Alicia Pigue, Recorder. Alderman Bob Pigue, absent.

Others present: Chief Jenkins, Chief Jernigan, Phillip Cobb and Junior Jordan

Mayor Williams called the meeting to order and gave invocation.

Mayor Williams presented the minutes of May 2019. Alderman Scotty Runions moved to accept the minutes as written. Alderman Lee Overton seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.

Phillip Cobb with Pictsweet Company presented a Quitclaim Deed for property that the City of Bells owns on Christian Avenue. Mr. Cobb requested the Mayor sign the Quitclaim Deed in order for the City to convey the property to the Pictsweet Company. Alderman Scotty Runions moved to authorize Mayor Williams to convey the property to Pictsweet Company and sign the Quitclaim Deed as requested. Alderman Lee Overton seconded the motion. Therefore Mayor Williams called for a roll call vote with four Aldermen present and all four Aldermen voting, Aye. Motion carried.

Alderman Dabney Long discussed flooding on Bellemeade Road with Mr. Cobb. Mr. Cobb reported that the Pictsweet Company is working on the drainage system on the Pictsweet farm land that some of the water comes from during flooding. He also stated that the City should look into redoing some of its drainage systems as well since some of the flooding is from the neighborhoods and not the farm land.

Mayor Williams presented the May financials and the Year to Date financials along with the bank balances.

Mayor Williams presented **ORDINANCE NO. 06102019** "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO 06112018 OF THE CITY OF BELLS, TENNESSEE APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND ESTABLISHING A PROPERTY TAX RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2018 THRU JUNE 30, 2019." Alderman Scotty Runions moved to adopt the Ordinance on its second and final reading and same be made a part of the minutes of this meeting in its entirety. Alderman Dabney Long seconded the motion. Thereupon Mayor Williams called for a roll call vote with all Aldermen voting, Aye. Motion carried.

Mayor Williams discussed getting bids for Oakmont Cove along with Christian Avenue and Crider Avenue.

Mayor Williams discussed the Cemetery and the whereabouts of the grave of Ms. Ollie Anderson.

Being no further business Alderman Scotty Runions moved the meeting adjourn. Alderman Dabney Long seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.
