

BELLS BOARD MEETING  
JUNE 22, 2015

Aldermen present: Bob Pigue, Scotty Runions, John Pigue, Dabney Long and Eric Jordan. Mayor Joe M. Williams, presided. Alicia Pigue, Recorder.

Others present: Chief Jernigan, Bobby Tucker and Junior Jordan.

Mayor Williams called the meeting to order and gave invocation.

Alderman Eric Jordan moved to accept the minutes of the previous meeting as written. Alderman John Pigue seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.

Alderman Scotty Runions moved to adopt Ordinance no 06222015 **“AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BELLS, TENNESSEE, ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET AND TAX RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2015 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2016”** on its second and final reading and same be made apart of the minutes of this meeting in its entirety. Alderman Eric Jordan seconded the motion. Thereupon Mayor Williams called for a roll call vote with all Aldermen being present and all Aldermen voting, Aye. Mayor Williams declared the motion carried.

Mayor Williams presented a proposal for The Pictsweet Company to raise the City of Bells portion to 15% of the Lagoon expenses and lower Pictsweet’s portion to 85%. Alderman Bob Pigue moved to accept the proposal as presented. Alderman John Pigue seconded the motion. Thereupon Mayor Williams called for a roll call vote with the following results: Alderman Eric Jordan, “Nay”; Alderman Dabney Long, “Nay”; Alderman John Pigue, “Aye”; Alderman Scotty Runions, “Nay”; Alderman Bob Pigue, “Aye”. The “Nays” having the vote Mayor Williams declared the motion as failed.

As a result of the failed motion The Board of Aldermen requested that Mayor Williams send a letter to Pictsweet officials requesting their presence at the next Board meeting.

Alderman Bob Pigue moved to raise the dollar amount needed for a Purchase Order from \$50 to \$100. Alderman John Pigue seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.

Alderman Bob Pigue discussed speeding on Main Street and grass overgrowth on Hwy 79 coming in from Humboldt.

Alderman Dabney Long discussed property owners not taking care of their property.

Being no further business Alderman Eric Jordan moved the meeting adjourn. Alderman Bob Pigue seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.
