BELLS BOARD MEETING

Aldermen present: Bob Pigue, Scotty Runions, Lee Overton and Eric Jordan. Mayor Joe M. Williams, presided. Alicia Pigue, Recorder. Alderman Dabney Long, absent.

Others present: Junior Jordan, Richard Chapina and Mark Wallace

Mayor Williams called the meeting to order and Alderman Bob Pigue gave invocation.

Mayor Williams presented the minutes of June 2019. Alderman Eric Jordan moved to accept the minutes as written. Alderman Scotty Runions seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.

Bells City School Superintendent, Mark Wallace, presented the 2019-2020 FYE Budget for the School. Alderman Eric Jordan moved to approve the budget as presented. Alderman Scotty Runions seconded the motion. Mayor Williams presented a Resolution of the City of Bells for Administrative Services to select Community Development Partners to provide assistance in the administration of the City's current LPRF grant. Mayor Williams presented a Resolution of the City of Bells for Engineering Services to select TLM Associates to provide assistance in the preparation and implementation of the City's 2019 LPRF

project. Alderman Scotty Runions moved to accept the Resolution as presented. Alderman Eric Jordan seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.
