

BELLS BOARD MEETING
OCTOBER 15, 2015

Aldermen present: Bob Pigue, John Pigue, Dabney Long and Eric Jordan. Alderman Scotty Runions, absent. Mayor Joe M. Williams, presided. Alicia Pigue, Recorder

Others present: Mark and Alecia Warren, Roger Parker, Chief Jenkins and Junior Jordan.

Mayor Williams called the meeting to order and gave invocation.

Alderman Eric Jordan moved to accept the minutes of the previous meeting as written. Alderman Dabney Long seconded the motion. All aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.

Mayor Williams presented Ordinance No CAT09142015 **“AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BELLS, TENNESSEE, REGULATING THE KEEPING OF LARGE NUMBERS OF ANIMALS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY,”** for its second reading. Mr. and Mrs. Mark Warren gave a brief presentation on why and how the ordinance should be amended to better service the Citizens. The Board of Mayor and Aldermen tabled the ordinance until the next regularly scheduled board meeting.

Mayor Williams discussed making the front of City Hall ADA compliant. Alderman Bob Pigue moved to hire Lonnie Hendrix to do the repairs and renovations. Alderman Eric Jordan seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.

Mayor Williams reported that VIP is 8 months behind on the rent payments for the City’s industrial building. Alderman Bob Pigue moved to inform Mr. Acor that in order to stay in the building he must be willing to be present at the next board meeting with a Statement of Intentions and a plan to repay the rent. Alderman John Pigue seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.

Alderman Dabney Long moved to offer the Water Tower as a base for equipment to WISPER internet service for \$200 per month. Alderman John Pigue seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.

City Superintendent Junior Jordan discussed handheld software with Mayor Williams.

Being no further business Alderman Eric Jordan moved the meeting adjourn. Alderman John Pigue seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.
